

Board of Appeal and Equalization Meeting
April 14, 2026
St. Lawrence Township

Pledge of allegiance was cited.

The local board of appeal and equalization meeting was called to order by Ted Kornder on April 14, 2026 at 7:00 p.m.

Ted read an opening statement describing the process of the Board of Appeal and Equalization Meeting so that everyone understood.

Roll Call: Ronald Symanitz, Supervisor, Ted Kornder, Chairman, Les Quatmann, Supervisor, Ramona Bischof, Clerk, Amy Mullen, Treasurer. Ron and Ted are certified. Others present were Chad Bohnsack and Briley Haugh from the Scott County Taxation Department.

Chad Bohnsack and Briley Haugh from the Scott County Taxation Department were present to provide input with regards to residents addressing the value and classification of their January 2, 2026 assessments payable 2027.

Briley stated that they received one call from a resident of St. Lawrence Township but nothing more. Items that came before the meeting and on the consent agenda are as follows:

Leslie Quatmann – PID #10-9240170. Les stated that he sold 27+ acres but it was not adjusted on his real estate taxes. He stated it was sold and closed in October of last year. He stated that from what he can see, there has been no adjustment on his taxes per value. In looking at the property taxes, Chad and Briley showed Les where the tax amount did go down. Chad did state that because of that sale and others along the 169 corridor, his parcel was also revalued. Chad stated that he will have to talk with the tax department about whether the tax side is correct or not, but it should only include the parcel that is left. Briley said that the taxes for the new parcel are based off what is left. Chad said he will have Dana from Scott County Taxation follow up with Les about the tax part of it. Motion by Ted and seconded by Ron to affirm the value and class for Les's property. No further discussion. Motion carried. Les abstained from voting.

Ron asked about why our levy dollars never match up to what we get and about Dana's e-mail about filing for ag preserve funds. Chad said again because he is not on the tax side, that Ron should reach out to Dana at Scott County and ask her for more clarification.

No further business to come before the meeting. Motion by Ron Symanitz and seconded by Les Quatmann to adjourn. No further discussion. Meeting adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
